New 25,000 sq. ft. fabrication facility

SPECIALIZED FACILITIES

The Company completed construction of a new 25,000 square foot fabrication facility and a 6,500 square foot painting facility in September, 2008.

The two structures are connected by an overhead crane system which allows an assembly line approach to construction of piping spools, pipe modules, structural components and turnkey process skidded buildings.

The location of the site itself, along Highway 16, adjacent to oversize load corridors, allows for easy transportation access.

QUALITY MANAGEMENT

The Company's quality control programs are registered in Alberta, Saskatchewan, B.C. and Manitoba.

These permit the Company to construct and repair ASME B31.3 Process Piping, ASME B31.1 Power Piping, ASME Section VIII Division I Pressure Vessels, and A, E and H Fittings in accordance with CSA B51 specifications.

The Company's registered welding procedures allow piping fabrication to be completed using SMAW, GMAW, and GTAW processes on a variety of metals including carbon and stainless steels.

We are Gas Bonded in the province of Saskatchewan, allowing us to obtain permits for the installation of CSA B149 piping.

CES is a CWB multi-plant company certified to CSA W47.1 with registered welding procedures utilizing SMAW, GMAW, and GTAW processes for structural steel fabrication.
