What began as a single semi-trailer, purchased to haul Carson's first backhoe back in 1978 has grown into a fleet of 40 semi tractor units and 15 picker trucks, along with 50 truck drivers with class 1A license endorsements.

Today, picker and trucking work is done out of the Lampman, Halbrite, Carlyle, Swift Current, Lloydminster, and Wainwright branches.

Pickers are used for setting pumpjacks, treaters, F.W.K.O.s, separator, header and skid packages, compressors, bullets, storage tanks, test tanks, pop tanks, piping, modules, flare stacks, hauling tubing, pipe and rods, pile driving and man basket lifts.

Pickers and semi units have assigned trailers to their units. These trailers include tri-axle highboys, tri-axle lowbeds, tandem axle highboys and tandem axle lowbeds, along with tank trailers.

These trailers are used for heavy transporting of equipment such as pumpjacks, bases, tanks, vessels, tubing, buildings, skid packages and general oilfield equipment.

CES has a 60 ton double drop trailer with removable neck, which can be configured with a jeep and booster for a 38 wheel combination capable of moving our 52 tonne Iron Wolf.
